GUEST PLAYER INSTRUCTIONS

In accordance with the rules of the Tournament, a team is allowed to have up to five (5) guest players on their roster.

Many states have specific forms that they use for this purpose.

- If your Association has a specific Guest Player form, use it.
- If your Association does not have a specific Guest Player form, we require that you use the form available on our web site to add guest players to your team's roster.

Some important notes about guest players -

- 1) All guest players must be registered to the same organization as the team for which they are playing (USYSA, US Club Soccer, or Super Y-League).
- 2) You must have a current USYSA, US Club Soccer or Super Y-League player pass for each guest player.
- 3) Your Association must approve the addition of each guest player.
- 4) If you have a guest player from outside your home association, that player must have permission of his home association to participate in the Tournament.
- 5) Remember that the Tournament is at Christmas-time. We have found that last minute guest players become a problem in trying to get the necessary approvals.
- 6) Florida registered players, wishing to play as guests on Florida teams, must comply the Florida Youth Soccer Association By-Laws & Rules 2007-2008.
 - Rule 210 – Guest Playing
 - Rule 401.6.F - Poaching

Because of insurance requirements, there can be no exceptions to these rules.
